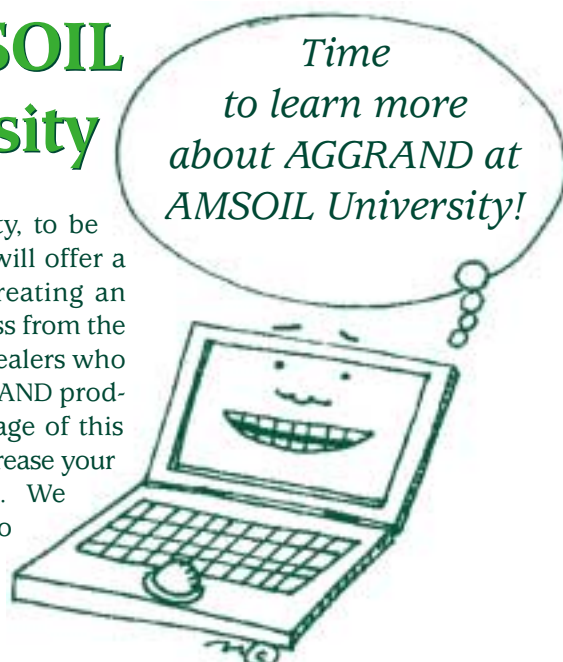

Wildlife Food Plots

Virginia DOT Uses AGGRAND Natural Liquid Lime

In August of 2000, the Virginia Department of Transportation contracted to have seed and lime applied to medians and around bridges on I-64 between Richmond and Virginia Beach.

Their biggest problem was bag lime dust, considering the 40,000 cars per hour traffic flow along this corridor. When AMSOIL Direct Jobber David Reid introduced them to AGGRAND Natural Liquid Lime, they were quite willing to give it a try. They put down the lime and seed together using a hydroseeder spray gun, saving a lot of operator time in the process. No sooner had the mixture been put down than it rained for three days.
