## Make the Transplant Period Easier with AGGRAND

Transplanting is a stressful period for young garden and vegetable plants. Minimizing transplant shock keeps plants growing vigorously, avoiding unnecessary setbacks that can delay flowering and reduce yields.

AGGRAND Natural Fertilizer (NOF) is ideal for watering-in small transplants. Use a mixture of three ounces of AGGRAND NOF per gallon of water. The addition of one or two ounces of AGGRAND Liquid Bonemeal (NBM) to the solution will increase phosphorus and calcium availability and aid the fertilizer in promoting long-term root development. One-half to one ounce per gallon of AGGRAND Natural Kelp and Sulfate of Potash (NKP) at planting

helps reduce susceptibility to insects and disease by increasing cell wall thickness and nutrient absorption. Shrubs and trees should be soaked overnight in a bucket of AGGRAND NOF solution before transplanting. Use one ounce per gallon of water for bare root soaking.

- Avoid transplanting during the day to avoid root desiccation or drying out.
- Cloudy weather is the best time to transplant.
- Keep the soil moist until plant root systems become well-established.
- Use a mixture of one ounce of AGGRAND NOF and one-half ounce of AGGRAND NKP with one gallon of water for bare root soaking.

## Using AGGRAND Natural Liquid Lime

The typical granular or bagged limestone application for field or garden will specify to apply a certain pounds-per-acre or per 100 square feet in order to raise the soil pH, increasing alkalinity. Depending on how fine the lime is and the character of the soil, it could take three years to raise the pH of the soil one point. The time usually allowed for all the limestone to break down and become a useful part of the soil is around three years. Most ground limestone is usually fine enough for 50 percent of it to pass through a 100 mesh screen.

The limestone in AGGRAND Natural Liquid Lime is a very finely ground dolomitic limestone, with 95 percent passing through a 325 mesh screen. When mixed with water according to directions, the lime becomes available to the plant immediately. This readily available calcium in the soil around the plants encourages the utilization of other nutrients. The crop responds with vigorous, green growth since it can now use nutrients more effectively. Order the G-1374 soil test kit and let us help you determine your liming requirements.
